Finishing Instructions

Cut the following:

Border (Magenta Plaid Kaleidoscope) — 1 yard x WOF cut

□ Subcut into (9) 3 ½" strips

Binding (Pink Coral Shimmer)– $^{3}4$ yard x WOF cut \Rightarrow Subcut into (10) 2 $^{1}2$ " strips

Border Instructions:

1. The center of your quilt should measure 72 ½" x 88 ½."

2. For the border, you'll need (4) strips for the top and bottom borders and (5) strips for the left and right borders.

- 3. Join (2) of the 3 ½" WOF border strips, ensuring the seam excludes the selvage. Repeat for another (2) 3 ½" WOF border strips. You should now have (2) 3 ½" border strips that are approximately 84" in length. These will be for your top and bottom borders.
- 4. Trim both your top and bottom border strips to 72 ½" in length.
- 5. Pin and attach top and bottom border strips with a ¼" seam.
- 6. Join (3) of the 3 ½" WOF border strips, ensuring the seam excludes the selvage. Trim length of strip to 94 ½."
- 7. Using the remainder of the strip from step 6, join to the remaining (2) of the 3 ½" WOF border strips, ensuring the seam excludes the selvage. Trim length of strip to 94 ½." You should now have (2) 3 ½" border strips that are exactly 94 ½" in length. These will be for your left and right hand borders.
- 8. Pin and attach left and right border strips with a ¼" seam.

Finishing Instructions:

Once the quilting is complete, trim quilt to finished size. Join the (10) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " binding strips together with diagonal seams, ensuring the seams exclude the selvage. Attach using your favorite method (I use a 3/8" seam when attaching my binding to my quilt).
